Community Racer Clinics

Exposure is a powerful tool. The primary goal of the Let's Grow STEAM^x community racer clinics is to expose youth to the educational opportunities afforded through the re-energized sport of soap box derby. Through the construction of an aero-dynamic racer, participants learn the science and math behind this sport as well as develop a confident STEAM identity, cultivate connection to community and IGNITE a love for lifelong learning. Participants are also taught lessons about sportsmanship and team work as we provide them with the thrill of competing in a racer they build in collaboration with family and friends. In a nut shell, community racer clinics are exciting educational experiences hosted in informal settings which offer lasting, positive, and meaningful outcomes for participants. Let's Grow STEAM^x believes one of the best things about derby racing – it's a family affair! You will see single parents, grandparents, community surrogate parents, and traditional families all supporting their youth racer. Community derbies are a great connector for students and parents alike; helping to make new friends that last beyond their racing careers. Let's Grow STEAM^x believes ALL children are equal when racing down a racetrack, no matter what their limitations may be.

In an effort to stay true to our intention of providing access to ALL students at no cost, our derby clinics are open to any student Pre-K thru 12th grade who desire to participate. However, nominal fees are required for community derby rallies and races. Students may apply for sponsorship or scholarship for rally and race fees through our program.
